



CONTINUED FAQ:

Q: ARE MASKS REQUIRED IN THE STUDIO CLASSROOMS & LOBBIES?

A. YES for dancers ages 6 and up. NO for dancers under age 6. These are the guidelines that have been given to us by the Sedgwick County Health Department and are based on the number of cases in our community. Should the spread of Covid-19 be minimized, this policy will be re-evaluated and may be subject to change. Until further notice, masks are required for anyone age 6+ in any area of the building, unless you have a medical exemption.

Q: WILL YOU CONTINUE TO SANITIZE DANCER HANDS?

A. YES. We utilize a "sanitize in & out" policy and have sanitizing stations at the door of each studio. We ask dancers to observe this policy when entering/exiting the studios classrooms.

Q: I'M UNCOMFORTABLE DROPPING MY YOUNG DANCER OFF IN THE DRIVE THOUGH LINE. CAN I COME INSIDE TO DROP OFF?

A. YES for dancers ages 6 and under, one parent/guardian can walk them into the building to assist with hand-washing and getting shoes on. Once those tasks have been accomplished, we ask that the parent return to the car to wait and/or observe via ZOOM until class dismissal.
